Abott and Fenner Scholarship

- Eligibility: High school juniors and seniors and current undergraduate students.
- Award Amount: \$1,000

AES Engineering Scholarship

- Eligibility: High School seniors and current undergraduates may apply. Do not need to take any engineering courses to be eligible.

- Eligibility: Current high school sophomore, junior, or senior with a "C" GPA or better. Must be a current varsity athlete in at least one sport and be committed to Christ who embodies the Playing with Purpose message.

American Advertising Federation of Baltimore Scholarship
