Financial Aid Process Overview

- Complete FAFSA
- Submit requested paperwork
- Determine student eligibility
- Receive financial aid award info
- Activate aid
- Disbursement of funds
- Apply again

Complete your 2014-2015 FAFSA

- Available January 1 every year
- www.fafsa.gov
- February 15 priority deadline
- School code 002065
- Estimate 2013 income to meet deadline
- IRS Data Retrieval Tool

Items needed to complete the FAFSA

- Student SSN, driver's license number
- Parent (s) SSN
- 2013 W-2s for student and parent(s)
- 2013 taxes, if completed
- 2013 child support paid or received
- VA benefits
- Bank account info
- Investment info
- Student and parent PIN #

Common FAFSA Errors

- Missing signatures (pin #s)
- Reporting grants/scholarships as part of income
- Reporting taxes paid as greater or equal to income
- Reporting parent or student income info in wrong section
- Household size and # in college
- Not updating income info after filing taxes

IRS Data Retrieval

- Available about 3 weeks after electronic filing of taxes
- Log into FAFSA
 - Choose Make FAFSA Corrections
 - Go to Financial Information section

When IRS DRT does not work

- Money is owed to IRS
- Parents are married but file separately or Head of Household

- Amended tax return
- Foreign or Puerto Rican tax return

If ineligible for IRS DRT

 Update FAFSA manually with figures from submitted tax return

Be prepared to obtain a <u>tax return</u>
 <u>transcript</u> from the IRS if requested



Submit requested paperwork by April 1

- Check NDM email
- Check Web Advisor
 - Financial Aid
 - My Documents
- Common requests

Determining Students Eligibility

- FAFSA results (estimated family contribution)
- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and Scholarship requirements
 - **GPA**
 - Pace (Completion of Credits)

SAP/Scholarship Policy

Warning

- After the first time requirements are not met, a warning status is in place for the next semester.
- If requirements are met at the end of that semester, the warning is lifted.

Suspension

 Eligibility for aid is suspended if the requirements are not met during the semester of warning.

Appeal


• Student may submit an appeal if there were unusual circumstances that caused the difficulty.

• If the appeal is approved, the funds are received with a probationary status for the following semester and subject to certain conditions being met.

Receive Financial Aid Award



- Notice is sent beginning in March



If you don't get your financial aid notice for 2014-15 by March

- Missing documents
- Rejected FAFSA
- Graduation date listed as May 2014
- On warning or probation for spring semester
- Check Web Advisor
- Contact Office of Financial Aid

- Institutional apply ONLINE in May
 - Notre Dame Scholarship 3.0 GPA
 - Notre Dame Book Store Scholarship 2.0 GPA

- April l deadline

Other options to consider

• MD Workforce Shortage Grant

- Nursing, education
- Application due July 1
- \$4,000/yr for full time students
- Service obligation

- Apply through MD CAPs account

TEACH grant

- 3.25 GPA
- Service obligation to teach in title I school, high-need field
- \$3,712/yr max for full time students

Loans

- Direct Loans
 - Subsidized
 - Unsubsidized
- Parent PLUS Loan
- Private/Alternative Loan

Activate Financial Aid

- Direct subsidized/unsubsidized loans are automatically renewed if you borrowed before (new borrowers: check with Financial Aid Office)
- Apply for Parent PLUS loan (May 1)
 - 1) Credit Check/Approval (online)
 - 2) Master's Promissory Note (MPN) (online)
 - 3) NDM Parent PLUS Request Form (paper)

Activate Financial Aid

- Thank-You Letters for Endowed scholarships (fall)
- Work Study check email for updates
- State aid use MD CAPS system <u>https://mdcaps.mhec.state.md.us</u>
 - Apply online for certain scholarship programs
 - Check your To Do List
 - Check your Application Status
 - See if MHEC has received your FAFSA
 - Accept or Decline Awards
 - Check Award and Payment Status
 - Change Enrollment Status
 - Change Housing Status

Special Conditions

- Change of Income in 2014
- Separation, Divorce, Death
- High Medical Expenses paid during 2013
- One-Time Income included in 2013 AGI
- Parent attending college


