EDU 410 Internship: Teaching in Early Childhood Ed

- The internship is a non-paid experience and there is a student teaching fee to be paid in addition to the tuition charges.
- For those students completing a second certification, the experience can be completed in the same semester - the internship experience would be divided into 10 weeks in elementary and 10 weeks in either early childhood or special education – depending on the second certification pursued.
