## Characteristics of Fall 2021

### First Time Full-Time Degree Seeking Students (cohort)

- 78% Maryland residents
- 22 % Residents of 14 different states: AZ, CA, CT, DE, GA, MA, MO, NC, NH, NY, OR, PA, VA, WA.
- 8% white, 34% represent at least one minority ethnic group, and 58% declare an unknown race or ethnicity
- Among the minority ethnic groups: 39% Black or African American, 55 % Hispanic, and 3% Asian

### Undergraduate Women's College Students (includes cohort)

- 89 % Maryland residents
- 11 % Residents of 20 different states: AZ, CA, CT, DE, GA, IL, MA, MO, NC, NH, NJ, NY, OR, PA, SC, TN, TX, VA, WA, and WV.
- 24% white, 52% represent at least one minority ethnic group, and 23% declare an unknown race or ethnicity
- Among the minority ethnic groups: 48% Black or African American, 29 % Hispanic, and 15% Asian
- 1 % International or Foreigner

### Total Student Body (undergraduate and graduate)

- 86% Maryland residents
- 12 % Residents of 36 different states: AR, AZ, CA, CT, DC, DE, FL, GA, HI, ID, IL, IN, LA, MA, MI, MN, MO, NC, NH, NJ, NV, NY, OH, OK, ON, OR, PA, RI, SC, TN, TX, UT, VA, WA, WI, and WV.
- 44% white, 43% represent at least one minority ethnic group, and 13% declare an unknown race or ethnicity
