

EXPECTATIONS


Students are responsible for:

- Completing the FAFSA
- Submitting additional Information (when requested)
- Completing Offer in self-service
- Maintaining Minimum GPA for Federal Funding
- Maintaining Minimum GPA for NDMU Scholarships

Parents are responsible for:

 Providing necessary documentation as needed by the student.

(Parents may be involved depending on your situation and the release of information)



Students will log into self-service using their NDMU credentials. Each Time a student logs into self-service, they will have notifications at the top of their screen.

Students can track their bills, courses, grades and financial aid in the portal.




State of Maryland Scholarships

The state uses the information on the FAFSA to determine eligibility for many of the scholarships; however, some scholarships require separate applications. All scholarships are renewable and require the student to complete the FAFSA each academic year.

- Senatorial Scholarship
- Delegate Scholarship

TIPS for Scholarship searches:



Never pay for an application



Always apply directly to the source when possible (ie: if the scholarship is sponsored by Google, use the application on the Google Website rather than a third party)

WHEN IS FINANCIAL AID POSTED TO ACCOUNTS?

Students can expect their financial aid to be disbursed to their student financial account after the add/drop period has ended for the students' program. This timing allows for students to adjust schedules and be sure they are registered for full-time. (12+ credits)

* students not registered fulltime, SOME funds may still be available.



Refunds:


- Issued within 14 days of disbursement
- Issued by the business office

Requirements for disbursement:

- Students must be registered as a full-time student.*
- Have submitted all required documentation
- Accepted aid in self-service
