OFFER

Accept your offer of admission and see what to expect next

I-20

The I-20 will be issued after you complete and submit the "Requirements for I-20 Processing", which can be accessed through International Students' Admissions Information website.

VISA INTERVIEW

Since visa appointments are limited and visa processing times can be lengthy, make the appointment as early as possible. Consulates will generally accept appointment up to 120 days prior to the start of studies.

HEALTH & IMMUNIZATIONS

NDMU requires all entering students to provide proof of immunity for several infectious diseases. Information about all required vaccines is available on the University's Immunization website.

SEVIS CHECK-IN

This is time-sensitive and must be done during the first week of the semester. Meet with your P/DSO to update your SEVIS status.

SEVIS I-901 FEE

The fee can be paid after the I-20 form has been issued. The fee must be paid prior to the visa interview. F1 Visa applicants pay \$350.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Federal regulations allow F-1 students to enter the U.S. no earlier than 30 days prior to the program start date on the I-20.

ORIENTATION

When on campus, Attend your school's orientation.
