### **PROCESS**

- All applications will be reviewed after the application deadlines (December 15, 2016 or February 15, 2017).
- · You may be requested to schedule an interview during the review process with the School of Nursing Admissions and Progression Committee.
- You will receive a letter regarding acceptance into the nursing major before or during the spring 2017 semester (depending on your application deadline).
- All decisions for acceptance are conditional: You must continue to meet the admission and progression criteria in spring 2017 and summer 2017 if needed for all coursework completed at Notre Dame of Maryland University or elsewhere.
- The Test of Essential and Academic Skills (TEAS) exam is required to be submitted with your application. Applications will not be reviewed without the TEAS exam results. The score received on the test will be included in the admissions process.
