

Housing Exemption Policy - Updated 2023

All full-time undergraduate students are required to reside on campus in the residence halls during their freshmen and sophomore year as specified in their financial aid award letter.

A student may submit a housing exemption request to the on-campus residence requirement for the reasons below:

- Student resides within 25 miles of NDMU's campus with their parent(s) or guardian.
- Student is twenty-one years of age or older.
- Student is married and/or has dependent children.
- Student is a military veteran.
- Student has a documented medical condition or disability that requires special living arrangements that residential life cannot reasonably provide within the residential living environment - (student will work with Office of Accessibility to be waived for this reason)
- Student has other extenuating circumstances and receives approval from Director of Housing & Residence Life or designee.

The Housing exemption request needs to be completed annually by the student.

Process:

- Student completes Housing Exemption Request (click to form).
- Student will receive communication from Housing & Residence Life with either an
 - o Approval of this housing exemption request or
 - Denial of this housing exemption request; student will be assigned to housing.
