The Nursing Mothers' Room was established to support working families at Notre Dame of Maryland University. This room is a private, quiet and peaceful space to let a nursing mother express breast milk for her nursing child for one year after the child's birth each time such employee or student has a need to express the milk. Be sure to speak with your supervisor about the amount of time you'll need to pump your milk, how it can fit into your workday schedule and how you can make up any extra break time that you take.
